

NURSE INTERN 2010 INFORMATION SHEET

1. Dates of Program: June 7 – August 13, 2010
2. This program requires your participation for the **entire** 10 weeks schedule, except for emergencies or illness. Any exceptions or special circumstances need to be discussed during the interview process.
3. Only active students in the Baccalaureate Degree Nursing program between Junior and Senior year during the summer of 2010 and Associate Degree Nursing program students after completing one year of nursing education are eligible to participate in our Student Nurse Intern Program.
4. In addition to all application materials, applicants are asked to submit an application and resume that includes all health care employment experiences and volunteer activities.
5. Salary: Will be competitive with the market. Internships with rotations will be eligible for differential pay.
6. Full-time hours are scheduled (72-80 hours per two weeks as dictated by unit scheduling policies). Some units have 8 hour shifts; others have 12 hours shifts or a combination of 8 and 12 hour shifts. Weekends are scheduled as every other or every third based on your preceptor's schedule. A few areas don't require weekend coverage on a usual basis. (e.g. Outpatient Services).
