Locations

Women & Children's Center (WCC) Classroom, St. Cloud Hospital, 1406 Sixth Avenue North, St. Cloud, MN 56303. Please park in the North Parking Lot* and enter through the North Entrance. Follow the hallway down to the Lakes Elevator. Take the elevator to the 3rd floor. Exit the elevator and the classroom is straight ahead.

South Point – Pelican Room

South Point | 3001 Clearwater Road, St. Cloud, MN 56301. Parking is available in the south lot. Take the elevator in the lobby to the Second Level. Follow the signs to the Pelican Room.

Objectives

Following the program, the participant will be able to:

- Identify the physiological changes that occur when a baby is born.
- List, in correct sequence, the appropriate steps during all stages of resuscitation.
- State the equipment and personnel needed to resuscitate a newborn.
- Describe the management of a newborn with meconium.
- Identify the basic principles of operation of positive-pressure ventilation devices.
- Describe the indications and appropriate technique for chest compressions and advanced airway management.
- Identify the indications and appropriate technique for use of pulse oximetry and blended oxygen.
- State the indications and contraindications for use of epinephrine and volume expander during resuscitation.
- Identify potential post-resuscitation complications, and at least one appropriate post-resuscitation action.
- Identify strategies for the management of the preterm infant.
- State the important ethical principles associated with neonatal resuscitation.

Target Audience

Healthcare professionals involved in any aspect of neonatal resuscitation, including physicians, nurses, advanced-practice nurses, nurse midwives, licensed midwives, respiratory care practitioners, and other healthcare professionals who provide direct care during neonatal resuscitation.

Contact Hour Information

This education offering has been designed to meet the Minnesota Board of Nursing continuing education requirements for 8 contact hours.

Course Description

The Neonatal Resuscitation Program (NRP) is an educational program that introduces the concepts and basic skills of neonatal resuscitation. The course has been designed to teach an evidence-based approach to resuscitation of the newborn utilizing a blended learning approach. This includes online testing, online case-based simulations, and hands-on case-based simulation/debriefing that focus on critical leadership, communication, and team-work skills.

Course Prerequisites

Textbook

Each participant needs to have studied the "Textbook of Neonatal Resuscitation 7th Edition" prior to class. Many institutions purchase manuals and allow staff to borrow them.

If your organization does not have a manual available, you may purchase one by contacting the AAP Online Bookstore at: <http://shop.aap.org/>. Alternatively, participants may also purchase their manual, by enclosing \$70.00 along with registration fee.

CentraCare Health employees will be provided with a manual to use for the course.

Online Exam

Each participant needs to have completed the "NRP Online Examination, 7th Edition" (Lessons 1-11 required) no more than 90 days prior to the class session.

After the online exam is complete, print out a verification of completion that will delineate which lessons have been successfully completed and the date. You must present this certificate to the identified instructor at the time of class.

You must successfully complete all relevant lessons of the exam and complete the hands-on classroom portion prior to the month of expiration on your existing NRP Provider Card, if you currently have one.
