

**RULES AND REGULATIONS**  
**DEPARTMENT OF UROLOGY**

**NAME**

The name of this organization shall be the Department of Urology, Saint Cloud Hospital Medical Staff.

**PURPOSE**

The Department of Urology shall provide quality care for urologic patients, provide educational programs for department members, the Medical Staff, and hospital personnel as necessary, and conduct peer review of activities in order to assure that appropriate treatment of urologic patients is provided by all members of the Medical Staff.

**MEMBERSHIP**

Practitioners who are members in good standing of the Medical Staff shall be eligible to be members of the Department of Urology. Membership will be limited to those physicians who are eligible to take the Board of Urology, or those who have privileges in the Department of Urology and limit their practices to urologic care and have education, training and demonstrated competence in the care and management of urologic patients.

The Department of Urology will recommend membership in the department to the Credentials Committee.

**ORGANIZATION**

Officers: There shall be a Chair and Vice Chair whose election, tenure, qualifications, removal, functions and responsibilities are as provided for in the Medical Staff Bylaws (Article 3, Officers). The Vice Chair will represent the Chair in his/her absence.

**FUNCTIONS**

Consultation: Members of the Department of Urology shall provide consultation to all members of the Medical Staff of Saint Cloud Hospital upon request.

Department members are encouraged to obtain consultations and/or referrals from other clinical specialties as appropriate.

It is the duty of the Chair of the Department of Urology to see that those providing urologic care to patients do not fail in the matter of ordering consultations or referrals when they are needed.

Education: The Department of Urology will be responsible to provide educational programs for the members of the department, for the Medical Staff, and the hospital personnel.

#### **ADOPTION AND AMENDMENT**

Rules and Regulations shall be submitted and voted upon by the membership. A majority vote is required for adoption or modification. These rules and regulations will be adopted, amended, repealed or added to according to Article 8 of the Medical Staff Bylaws and will become effective when recommended by the Executive Committee of the Medical Staff and approved by the Board of Directors.
