

Emergency Nursing Pediatric Course (ENPC)

2022 Course Schedule

Purpose

Accurate assessment of a child with an acute illness or injury requires special knowledge and skills. ENPC gives nurses the tools to provide expert care for patients from birth to adolescence.

Objectives

ENA developed the Emergency Nursing Pediatric Course to establish a standardized body of pediatric emergency nursing knowledge and to improve the care of all pediatric patients. This fifth edition course combines interactive learning with scenario-based assessments to give nurses a comprehensive learning experience.

A Systematic Approach of Initial Assessment

The first few minutes of medical and trauma care for a young person are critical to achieve better patient outcomes. The A-I mnemonic and the Pediatric Assessment Triangle will assist nurses in providing appropriate and early intervention.

Hands-on Training Using Both an Individual and Team Approach

Six teaching scenarios offer nurses the opportunity to practice the systematic approach of the initial assessment in real-life situations.

1.5-Day Intensive Course with Expert Instructors

ENPC is a 1.5-day intensive course that is taught by expert instructors. There is a faculty ratio of approximately one faculty per four learners.

Evidence-based Content Developed by Pediatric Emergency Experts

A 23-chapter comprehensive manual includes special emphasis on age and developmental stages.

5 Online Modules

Online learning allows nurses to learn at their own pace and refer back to information at any time.

Pre-requisite Requirements

Completion of the ENA pre-course online modules are required before attending class. Information on how to access these modules will be sent to participants, along with their textbook, at least 30 days prior to the course.

The ENPC Provider Manual, Fifth Edition, is included with course registration and is yours to keep.

Course Completion

Successful completion of the course requires 80% or greater on the multiple-choice exam and 70% or greater on the skill-station evaluation. RN candidates with successful completion will receive the ENA ENPC 4-year provider verification card.

Contact Hour Information

Participants earn 18.33 contact hours.

The Emergency Nurses Association is accredited as a provider of continuing nursing education by the American Nurses Credentialing Center's Commission on Accreditation.

The Emergency Nurses Association is approved by the California Board of Registered Nursing, Provider #2322.
